Acknowledgment of Country & recent changes

We wish to acknowledge the traditional custodians of the land on which we gather and proudly pay our respects to the Boonwurrung/Bunurong people of the Kulin Nations. Our community pays our respects to the Elders past, present and future as well as all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people.

The Boon wurrung or Boonerwung area commences at the Werribee River, spreads around the coastal part of Melbourne then East as far as Wilson's Promontory. The word Boon means "to speak or with the lips" and wurrung means language of the people.

The Mornington Peninsula Shire decided to rename Blacks Camp Road and the Blacks Camp Reserve during the process for the Council's Reconciliation Action plan and discussions with First Nation's people who agreed that the names were not appropriate.

Worwong was the traditional name for the location as referred to in William Thomas' Journals 1841 who was the Protector of Aborigines of Port Phillip who chronicled his life and work with Aboriginal Victorians recording the Kulin language. Blacks Camp Road is now **Worwong Avenue**.

The Blacks Camp Reserve is now **Beek Beek Reserve** and the Blacks Camp Preschool has changed it's name to **Tillerkite Preschool**.

We are very proud to announce that the Somerville Community House has received a grant to plant trees for The Queen's Platinum Jubilee 2020 at the Annie Sage Community Centre.



The Department of Industry, Science, Energy and Resources with support from Greg Hunt, (retired MP) has provided \$10,000.00 in funding so we can pay tribute to Her Majesty's 70 years of public service and support the Queen's Green Canopy global project.

A commemorative event is planned for the middle of September with the planting of the first tree and the unveiling of a permanent plaque to highlight this special project.

The plan is to plant over 30 trees in the yard of the Annie Sage Community Centre over the coming months into next year. We envisage espaliering a collection of heritage fruit trees on the existing internal fencing and to also plant a selection of native fruit trees within the grounds.

This layout will be designed by a qualified horticulturist and the trees planted by various local community groups and educational centres. A range of ongoing programs is expected to evolve from the process and at times the trees will be netted to protect their fruits while others will be left to the local birds and fauna.

The trees will be included in our strategic plan to ensure they are maintained and protected in years to come. We are hopeful that these trees will provide an ongoing source of enjoyment for all who visit the Centre.
